At The Observatory School we are committed to providing extensive support to the pupils who leave us after Year 11. We have a designated telephone number available during school hours and our former pupils are then guided appropriately to staff within school or external services who can help.

Support available to our leavers:

- Home visits
- Help with applications forms
- Visits/ Transport to Training Providers and Colleges
- Support with interview skills
- Advice and guidance from our Career advisor.
- EHCP/IEP and information pack

Some of our post 16 pupils take the opportunity on offer to come into School to receive 1-1 mentoring in subjects such as Maths and English.

The cohort for our Year 11 Leavers for 2018/19 academic year comprised of 17 pupils. 5 of the cohort were girls the remaining 12 were boys.

In July 2019 100% of leavers had secured placements of further education. In October 2019 94% of leavers were still secure on their placements. 1 pupil had changed her course.
