ATTENDANCE REMINDER


Please can we ask if your child is off school that you leave a message on the Absence Voicemail on 0151 652 7093 as soon as possible to let us know the reason for absence.

You can also advise via our Parentapp with just a few clicks.

- When your child is unwell please notify the school as soon as possible on the same day that your child will not be at school.
- If your child has not been marked for morning registration, the school will
 contact parents/carers by call/text by 10am. If you do receive a message
 or text it would be appreciated if you could reply by text or by phone as
 soon as possible.
- If the illness lasts longer than two days please keep the school informed as
 to what is happening and we can, if appropriate provide work or suggest
 ways that your child can learn whilst they are not at school.
- Please note that if the authenticity of an illness is in doubt the school can request parents to provide medical evidence to support the illness, this evidence can take the form of copies of prescriptions, appointment cards etc
- School starts at 8.55am, all pupils are expected to be in school and ready for registration at this time.
- If your child arrives late for school, please ensure that the Reception staff are made aware as to why your child is late.

Sometimes messages to teachers go unread as they are so busy so it is important that you notify us via the Absence Line or ParentApp.

If we have not heard from you, the absence will be followed up and if we cannot establish a reason for absence then it will be recorded as unauthorised absence.



MOBILE PHONES

Sadly Mobile phones are becoming a cause for concern within the school.

Can we remind you that in line with our school policy, mobile phones are banned from being used within the school.

Pupils will be asked to hand in their phones when they arrive on-site and are encouraged to handphones into staff, who will store them safely and return them at the end of the day.

If pupils refuse to hand over their phones Parents/carers will be contacted to collect the phone.

Mobile phones are not allowed for safeguarding reasons

We are pleased to inform you that we are changing how we communicate with you and have launched a brand-new School App from Parentapps.

Our new App is free to download and is available for both Apple and Android devices. Many of you have already signed up and are using the App, and we thank you for your continued support.

For those of you not yet using the App, you will have received a text or e-mail with further instructions on how to download and access the app. Please do download as it is free and takes up little memory on your Phone. But means you have instant access to school information

It will provide you with instant access to our term dates, event information, newsletters, social media, website, and much more. Additionally, you will be able to view and submit consent forms easily and receive secure documents.

The app will also enable you to invite additional family members, ensuring that the right people have access to important information. We will use the app to send targeted messages via push notifications so you aren't bombarded with messages that are not relevant.

Lastly, the app is fully secure and GDPR compliant, and to access it, you will need to be invited via email or SMS message.
