Key Stage 4 Curriculum Overview

In years 10 and 11 we continue to focus on pupils' long term goals and aspirations and adjust our curriculum accordingly. Every pupil continues to study English, maths, science, PE, ICT, PSHE, RE and art. Pupils access a range of accredited courses that are updated on an annual basis according to their needs and aspirations. Where we don't have a specialist within our team, we work with external partners to enhance our offer.

We offer GCSE, Functional Skills (1 and 2), ECDL, Entry Level and ASDAN qualifications.

Where the additional or special educational needs of pupils are such that they require bespoke or specialist support, we work with parents/carers and relevant professionals to build a package of personalised provision. Our offer for these pupils is rooted in the solid consensus that they need to prioritise the development of attendance, attributes and behaviours that will:

- 1. Keep them safe in school and in the community;
- 2. Support them to access the wider curriculum over time;
- 3. Support their transition to a more appropriate setting, if required;
- 4. Enable them to take advantage of opportunities, responsibilities and experiences later in life

These intensive packages are agreed through the annual review process and reviewed on a regular basis.
