Key Stage 4 Overview

In years 10 and 11 we continue to focus on pupils' long term goals and aspirations and adjust our curriculum accordingly. Every pupil continues to study English, maths, science, PE, ICT, PSHE, RE and art. Pupils access a range of accredited courses that are updated on an annual basis according to their needs and aspirations. Where we don't have a specialist within our team, we work with external partners to enhance our offer.

Pupils are placed on their appropriate pathway depending on their end of key stage 3 progression step. Those who achieve 9 or higher often are placed on the academic pathway. Those with 8 or lower are placed on our vocational pathway and those with a more bespoke curriculum are placed on the custom pathway.
