

Depression can affect anyone. It makes you feel miserable. Also, it can stop you from doing your job. If you feel you have depression, you should try meditating, exercising in the fresh air and eating more healthy. Although depression can feel hopeless, talking to someone can help.

Anxiety can affect many people. It makes your hands shake and gives you a headache. CBT and yoga helps. Anxiety links to depression and stress, because you're lonely and bored. Anxiety can feel very bad, but there are ways to help. Stress can affect anyone. Stress can make you feel like you want to shout or smash everything. Relaxation and exercise can help with stress. If stress is work related, you can talk to your employer to get some help.




### Parks - Art

This week the class used pastels to recreate famous landmarks around the world. Well done Paige, Fin and Adam.




